Beneficiaries in 2023

- **AHF Education** projects reached **103** girls and **87** boys through Debate competition and donations of learning materials.
- **1,821** girls were reached directly through our #PADAGIRL project in 2023
- **503** vulnerable people were reached through our relief support materials in Ijebu East local government of Ogun state
- A pair of Crutches was given to Mr Onakoya Durojaye
- Over 700 boys and less than 100 girls were reached through our football competition in Ijebu Ode/ Imusin
- AHF commemorated INTERNATIONAL DAY OF THE GIRL CHILD with 106 girls
- AHF commemorated #16daysActivismAgainstGenderBasedViolence with 50 people (20 males and 30 females)
